### FINAL RESULTS

Mark Herrington said he played below par this week but no one could stop him anyway, as the Germantown senior won his second consecutive TSSAA tennis championship yesterday.

Herrington, who will attend Clemson University in the fall, defeated Montgomery Bell Academy's Danny DeBlanc 6-4, 6-4 at Centennial Tennis Center for the singles crown, enabling Germantown to win its second straight boys' team title.

"I DIDN'T play that well all week," Herrington said after he wore down the game DeBlanc to post his 34th consecutive high

school singles win. "Today was better, but I'm still having trouble keeping my forehand in play."

Herrington used a tough net game though to stop the Big Red sophomore and end MBA's hopes of its first state championship since 1966.

Germantown finished the three-day tourney with 12 points, runner-up Brentwood Academy had 9 and MBA scored 8 points.
