TULLAHOMA, Tenn. – Trevor Sneed capped a McCallie rally with the game-winning hit in the bottom of the seventh as the Blue Tornado downed Baylor 13-12 to advance in the TSSAA Division II Baseball Tournament on Thursday.

McCallie (20-7) trailed 12-9 in the final inning before stringing five straight hits to score four runs. Greg Brazier had a two-run double to tie the game at 12-12 and Sneed had the game-winning hit down the leftfield line.

Baylor had a rally of its own with nine runs in the fourth to erase an early 7-0 deficit. Nerren Pratt had a three-run homer in the inning and drove in four runs in the game on two hits. Sneed also picked up the victory for McCallie with a scoreless seventh inning.

Ricky Honeycutt, son of former major league pitcher Rick Honeycutt, suffered the loss in relief for Baylor (17-15).
