



Tigers Toppled In State Finals

CHATTANOOGA — Marshall County coach Joe George was a man of few words last night. . .but then again there wasn't much he

could say.

George saw his Tigers go down in defeat for the second time in as many games, losing an 8-1 decision here to Notre Dame in the TSSAA Class AA state baseball championship series.

"I'm really disappointed we couldn't do better after we got here," said George, whose club was handed a 2-0 setback in the series' first game Thursday

night.

'They hit the ball and we didn't, not like we are capable of. Notre Dame is a well-coached team. We didn't play like we could, because it's my job to get them ready, and they weren't mentally ready for either game," George explained, being unnecessarily hard on himself.

Much of the credit and/or blame for last night's loss should go to Irish lefthander Mark Dennis, who ran his record to 13-1 with a four-

hitter.

Tiger ace Jesse Moore was not sharp, yielding eight hits in just four and 1/3 innings before being relieved by Haslip. The loss was only the second in 10 decisions for the junior righthander.

Notre Dame finishes the season with a 28-5 record while Marshall

County winds up 15-6.

Beer, which was on the concession menu Thursday night, was not available for the approximately 500 fans at Engel Stadium for last night's final game.
