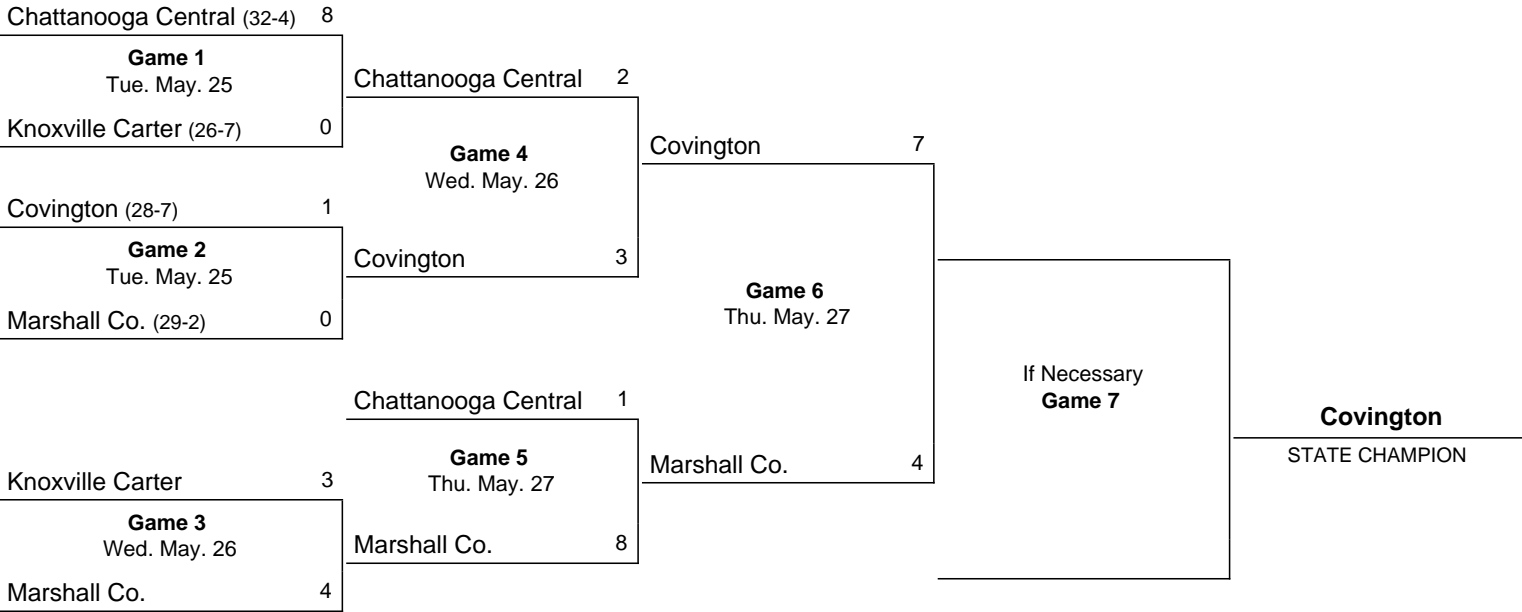

**CHATTANOOGA** -- Chattanooga Central's Josh Scott scattered four hits in posting a 8-0 victory over Carter in the first round of the TSSAA Class AA Baseball Tournament played at Engel Stadium.

Scott also drove the first run of the game with an RBI single to center to plate Eric Oliver, who led off the inning with a walk. He pitched the complete game, striking out five and walking two.

Central plated runs in each of the first four innings. The big blow in the three-run third inning was a two-run triple by Andy Nelson.
