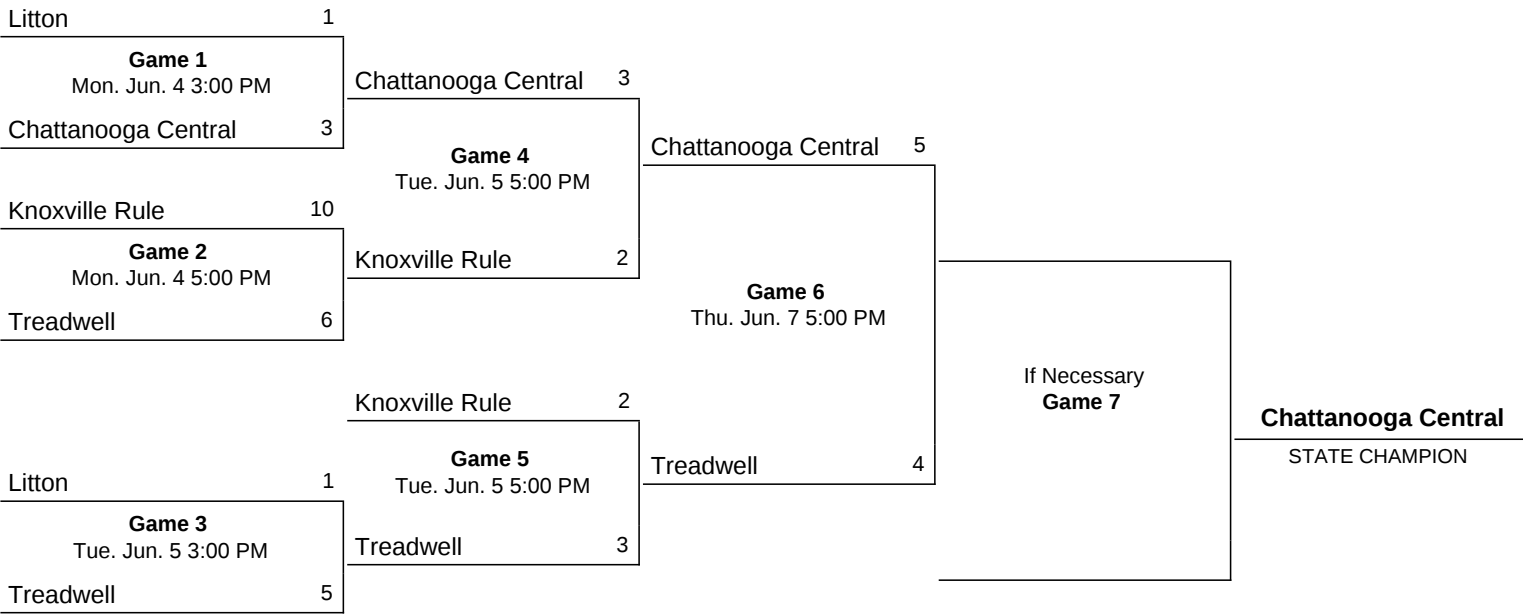

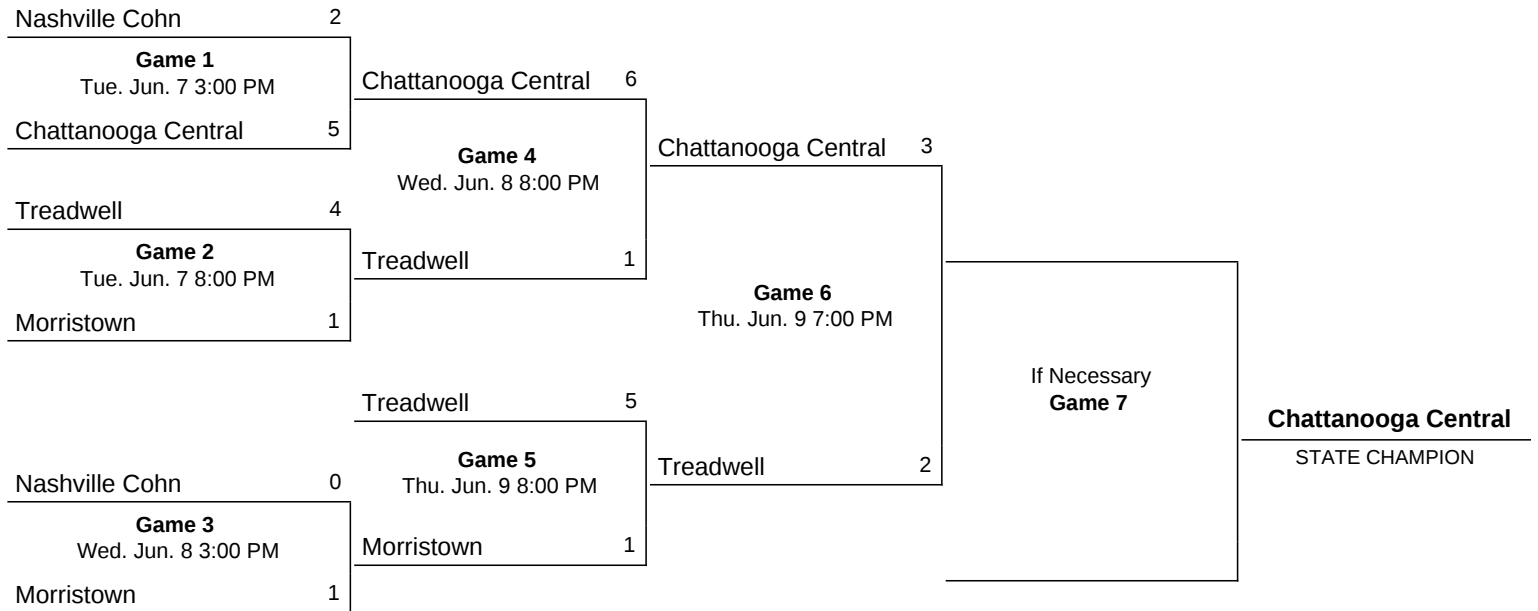

Pounders Trip Eagles For TSSAA Title

KINGSPORT — (P) — Bob Baskette's tie-breaking single in the last of the ninth with two outs and the bases loaded gave Chattanooga Central high school a 3 to 2 victory over Memphis Treadwell last night for the TSSAA baseball championship of 1955.

Central, finalist in the winner's bracket with two straight wins, took a 2-0 lead in the fifth inning when Royce Powell slammed an inside-the-park homer with Earl Ziegler on base.

Treadwell rebounded in the top of the sixth to tie it up at 2-2 on singles by Jimmy Martin, Ted Steele and Harold Daniel. From the sixth inning on, each team left runners stranded in every frame except the seventh, when Treadwell went down in order.
