KINGSPORT WINNER OF T. S. S. A. A. TRACK AND FIELD EVENT

East High and Peabody Are Far Back as 12 Teams Place

KNOXVILLE, Tenn., May 8.—(AP)—Kingsport High School scored a runaway victory in the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association state track meet at the University of Tennessee today, scoring 54 1-2 points, more than double the score of Knoxville High which placed second with 27 points.

Johnson City High trailed Knoxville High by only one point to place third. Only one other team was able to get as many as ten points, Memphis Tech taking fourth place with 13 tallies.

East High, of Nashville, entered only two men and gained five points as Tom Cook won the 440 dash. Ed Hiestand, of Peabody Demonstration School, placed second in the discus and third in the shot while Jack Evans took third place in the javelin. Smith, of Kingsport, and Wallin, of Johnson City, tied for individual scoring honors with 16 points each. Twelve schools broke into the scoring.
