Clarksville Cops Meet

MEMPHIS (AP)—Clarksville retained the Tennessee high school cross-country championship yesterday despite a new course record set by second place Nashville East's front runner.

The Clarksville harriers came in with 52 points, just under East's 57. Oak Ridge was third with 78, East Ridge fourth with 135 and Jackson fifth with 154.

Charles Dahlgren was ahead at the gun and led all the way, finishing the two-mile race in 10:19, a new record for the course at Memphis State.

Seven runners came in ahead of the old mark set last year at 11:02 by David Cardwell of Oak Ridge.
