'Cat Harriers Grab Crown

GORDON Wilson of Millington set a new record here yesterday as Clarksville won the sixth annual State cross-country meet

WILSON paced four performers who bettered or tied the old record of 10:26, set a year ago by Sam Rutherford of Battle Ground Academy.

Wilson rounded the mile course twice in 9 minutes, 57 seconds, clipping 29 seconds off Rutherford's mark. Don Brigham of Clarksville, 20 yards behind Wilson, ran the course in 10:01, followed by Steve Clinger of Memphis Catholic, 10:24, and Steve Nelson of Knoxville East, who tied Rutherford's mark. Rutherford this year was timed at 10:35 for sixth,

Clarksville's team title is its fourth in the six years of the TSSAA meet.

THE WILDCATS were charged with 47 points, to 84 for Memphis Frazer.

In third place was Holston Valley with 101, followed by Memphis Overton, 108; Knoxville East, 124; Memphis White Station, 214 and Memphis CBHS 221.
