FINAL RESULTS

State Tennis Tries To End Play Today

The TSSAA boys' tennis crown will hopefully be decided this morning after rain washed out the scheduled doubles match between Dan Buttrety and Rip Trammel of MBA and David Lipscomb's Gary Dunn and Gary Jerkins.

The match is rescheduled for 10 a.m. at Centennial Tennis Center, and the winners will walk away with the team crown.

Memphis Christian Brothers holds a one-point lead over Lipscomb and a two-point margin over MBA, but the doubles title would push either team into the championship.

SECOND DAY RESULTS

CHRISTIAN Brothers of Memphis is the current team leader with 10 points. But Lipscomb has nine and the Big Red eight with the doubles title adding three more points.

FIRST DAY RESULTS

IN THE BOYS' division, where Lipscomb won the doubles and tied for the team championship last year, the Mustangs and MBA are tied for the team lead with CBHS, each with five points.
