

CLASS AAA STATE BASEBALL TOURNAMENT

CHATTANOOGA -- Oakland's baseball team won the school's second state championship of the school year with a 10-0 victory over Farragut in the TSSAA Class AAA Baseball Tournament Friday at Historic Engel Stadium.

The school's football team won the Class 5A championship in December.

Tournament most valuable player Casey Rauschenberger provided the pop in Oakland's lineup. The Patriot third baseman doubled off the wall in left to drive in a run. His team thought the shot had gone over the wall. In the second inning, Rauschenberger left little doubt when he powered a shot over the 25-foot high wall in right-center to plate three runs, his 12th round-tripper of the season.

Jeremy Slayden added a two-run shot, also his 12th, over the wall in right-center in the fourth inning.

Jason Sharber (6-1) allowed two hits, walked one and struck out four hitters.

Matt Maples and Chris Goodrich had the hits for the Admirals (34-10).

The Patriots, ranked in the USA Today Top 25, finish the season with a 38-2 record.
