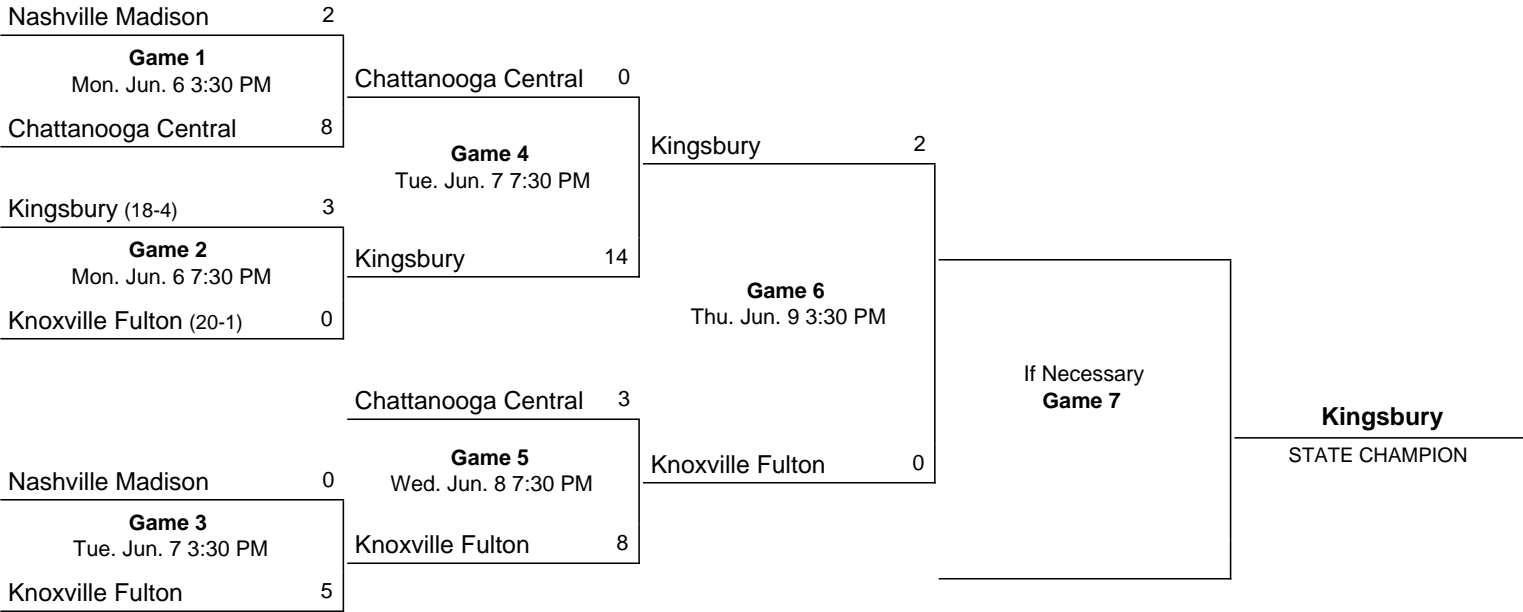

Knox Fulton Blasts Central, Gains Finals

MEMPHIS (AP) — Knoxville Fulton powered three runs in the top of the 13th inning yesterday to defeat Chattanooga Central 6-3 and move into the finals of the state high school baseball tournament.

KNOXVILLE faces Memphis Kingsbury today for the title.

The Purple Pounders opened with a surge as Orville Donahoo slugged a triple and Bob Burns singled him home. But that was all for the Region II champions until the sixth and seventh innings, when they added one each.

Knoxville recorded two runs in the fourth and one in the seventh before really letting loose in the fourth overtime inning.

The losing pitcher was Freddie Dukes. Chattanooga finished the season with an 18-3 record while Knoxville now is 22-2.

Kingsbury Tips Fulton

MEMPHIS (AP) — Memphis Kingsbury pushed across two runs in the second to defeat Knoxville Fulton for the State high school baseball championship, 2-0 yesterday behind the four-hit pitching of Ken Kauerz and Brantley Jones.

IT WAS the ninth prep basketball title for the Memphis Prep League and wound up the season for Kingsport with a 21-4 mark.

Falcon first baseman Billy Rasbach opened the second with a double, and scored on Jimmy Young's single. Young stole second and went to third when catcher Jerry Russell threw wide. Young was caught off moments later, but slid home under the tag of pitcher Steve Major.
