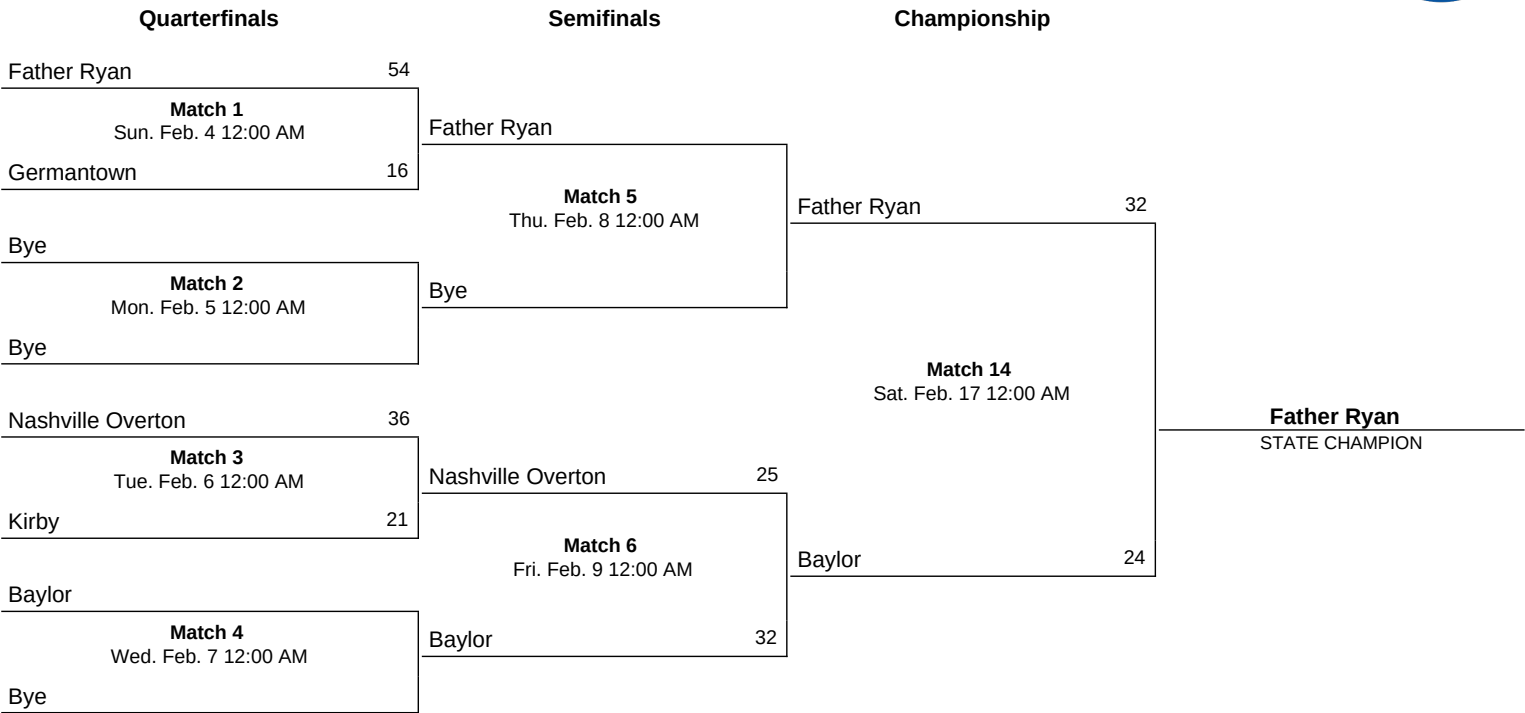

Bradley places second in Class Large tourney

MEMPHIS — For the second straight Saturday, Bradley Central and McCallie met in the championship final of a tournament and the Blue Tornado topped the Bears, 40-20, Saturday night for the Class Large state duals title.

Bradley Central, after state tournament victories over Overton and Kirby, won four weights but fell short against the three-time defending state champs.

Daniel Jordan (130) won against McCallie's Lance Lindsey with a pin in 5:40.

Blake Arnett (135) won by a 7-3 decision for the Bears against David Blanding. Israel Heil (152) of Bradley pinned Martin Hummings in 5:38, while Alan Patterson (160) won by technical fall for BCHS over Jahmal Overton, 17-2.

"I'm proud of them. We were a little flat in the finals, but I contribute some of that to McCallie. They wrestled well," said Steve Logsdon, head coach of the Bears. "We lost a couple we shouldn't have, but I hope it helps the guys get ready for what's ahead (Saturday's region tournament at Cleveland)."

At 140, Wes Eshenbrenner of Bradley Central and A.J. Ford finished regulation tied at 5-all. Ford registered a takedown in overtime for the win.

McCallie defeated Bradley Central, 30-24, in last week's Region 2 Class Large duals final.

The Bears reached the final with a 32-24 victory over Kirby.

"I was real concerned with Kirby," Logsdon said. "I watched them against Karns (in Friday's first round) and after that I knew we'd need a good effort. I anticipated a hard-nosed team and that's what we faced."

Arnett and Heil had pins against Kirby. Chuck Rymer (189) won by technical fall for the Bears and Benji Stone (119), Jordan, Eshenbrenner, Steven Falls (145) and John Pohlner (171) had decision wins.

Arnett's pin was against Chris Hunter who placed in the state last year.

Bradley Central opened against Overton Friday and won, 42-18.

For BCHS, Joe White (112), Eshenbrenner and Rymer won with

Jordan at 130 was defeated in overtime, 6-4, by Chasen Waugh.
